Code of Conduct

In order to insure that everyone knows what will be permitted and discouraged, we have included behavior, etiquette, and dress code rules. Failure to comply with the following may result in expulsion from the Prom.

No PDA (Public Display of Affection)

- Girls sitting on boy's laps or vice versa
- Caressing or extended embracing
- No holding hands unless dancing
- Kissing

Proper Dance etiquette and behavior require that there is NO:

- Body against body
- Groping
- Provocative Movements/Dirty Dancing

The Redmen Hall Facilities

- Please stay inside the building. No outside visiting allowed for any length of time.
- We expect each family to enjoy the activities with the group and discourage any private time alone.

Dress Code

Ladies Attire

- Long gowns are encouraged but not required.
- Modest and becoming gowns.
- Spaghetti straps and strapless gowns are permitted, however no plunging necklines.
- Undergarments must be worn under gown.
- No side or front cut-outs in dresses below natural bra line.
- The gown's back may not be lower than the smallest portion of the natural waist line.
- No see through gowns are permitted.
- Please use your Utmost Discretion when selecting a gown to assure that it is tasteful and above reproach.

Gentleman's Attire

- Tuxedo or Dress Suit
- No earrings

(A Dress Suit is defined as matching pants and jacket)

All Attendees

No visible tattoos or body piercing. (Clear spacers may be used to insure that "piercings" do not close. These are available most places where body piercings are sold.)

General Agreement

(This Release form must be signed by attendees in space indicated)

In consideration of being permitted to participate in the Homeschool Promenade all participants (hereinafter referred to as "Family") agree to the following:

1. Release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue either the Homeschool Promenade, Redmen Hall, Waco, Texas, or any other location of Ball activities, (herein referred to as "Promenade Activity Locations"), their officers or other families participating in the Homeschool Promenade (hereinafter referred to as "Releases") from all liability to Family for any loss or damage and any claim or damage on account of injury to the person or property or resulting in death of a Family member, whether caused by the negligence of Releases or otherwise Family is participating in activities of Homeschool Promenade or any other activities on the premises of Promenade Activity Locations.
2. Family agrees to indemnify Releases from any loss, liability, damage or cost Releases may incur due to the presence of Family in or on the premises of Promenade Activity Locations.
3. Family assumes full responsibility for and rest of bodily injury, death or property damage due to negligence of Releases or otherwise while in or on the premises of Promenade Activity Locations and/or while working or for any purpose participating in the activities of the Homeschool Promenade..
4. Family states that both Mother and Father of Family has carefully read the above release and knows the contents of the release and signs this release as Family's own free act.
5. Family releases all officials and professional personnel from any claim whatsoever on account of first aid, treatment or service rendered Family during participation in the Homeschool Promenade...
6. The parties to this agreement are Christians and believe that the Bible commands them to make every effort to live at peace and to resolve disputes with each other in private (see Matthew 18:15-20; 1 Corinthians 6:1-8). Therefore, the parties agree that any claim or dispute arising from or related to this agreement shall be settled by biblically based mediation.
7. This agreement shall be binding on each member of the Family, their personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin.
8. This release contains the entire agreement between the parties to this agreement and the terms of this release are contractual and not a mere recital.
